Background

Flooding occurred in Chautauqua County beginning Tuesday, July 14<sup>th</sup>. Many small creeks overflowed flooding basements and first floor living quarters in some homes. Towns impacted are Brockton, Westfield, Portland and some in Fredonia. A disaster assistance center has been established in the town of Portland where those impacted can report their damage. DLAN tickets are then developed. As of July 20<sup>th</sup>, there were ~20 health and human services requests and 46 homes for muck-out. Teams from UMCOR and another agency out of Connecticut have responded to four sites and completed work on those four homes. Catholic Charities has been contacted to help with some of the human services needs and the county is looking for ways to supplement food stamps.
